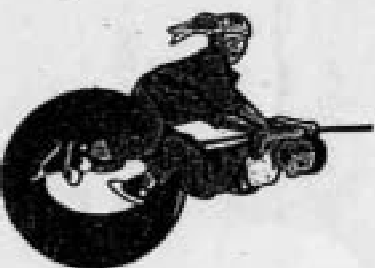

- Maintaining appropriate physical boundaries
- Develop a sense of empathy for others
- Give and receive compliments
- Determining whether a topic is appropriate or not
- Learning table manners
- Understanding rules for community activities
- Interacting appropriately with adults
- Developing self-calming techniques
